Some information about the Oratory contest

- **Topic for 2009 / 10 will be published soon.**
- Contest will be held in three age categories namely under 12yrs, 12 to 16 and 16 to 18 years.
- Independent judges will judge Oratory contest.
- There will be three major prizes. All participants will receive consolation prizes.
- Your participating students will further promote their schools activities.

Objective

Promote Hindi Language and encourage oral Hindi Speaking Skill.

Eligibility

Open to Hindi School students for all ages.

Oratory Criteria

Time: Speakers under 12 years age category allowed up to 3 minutes
Speakers in age category 12 to 15 years allowed up to 4 minutes and
Speakers in age category 16 to 18 years allowed up to 5 minutes.

Guide lines for Judging Criteria follows:

- **Introduction of the topic: 10 points**
- **Subject material contents: 10 points**
- **Presentation skills: 10 points**
- **Reference to research sources : 10**
- **Clarity : 10 points**
- **Oral presentation with minimum reference to written material : 10**
- **Audience capture : 10**
- **Confidence and believe in the deliberation : 20**
- **Concluding the topic 10**

Judging criteria will be same for each category.

Judges will be appointed by Hindu Heritage Society and decisions will be final.

Prizes

- **Each Participant will receive a prize**
- **First, Second and Third Prizes will be for each age Category**
- **The overall winner Trophy will for Schools to keep for a year and returned at the next annual Mata Saraswati puja.**
